

HOUSE RULES

- 1.** What is The Scout Centre Rome 60 ? Is the headquarters of our Scout Group AGESCI Roma 60 - based on being thrifty (9th article of Scout Law) - and not a bed and breakfast; it 's a building adapted and managed - on voluntary - by scout leaders, former leaders, adults and scout's parents; it's also an opportunity to meet other scouts as well as discover the kindness of the people who live in the suburbs of Rome;
- 2.** Cleaning: you have to keep perfectly clean the rooms assigned - at any time of the day - and work together to clean the common areas (in Rome there is the separate collection of the household waste), including toilets.
- 3.** Rules: the rooms will be assigned when the group is close to get there, taking care (if possible) of the needs expressed by the group leaders; the rooms are usually available from 14.00 on the day of arrival and must be released by noon on the day of departure.
- 4.** Public peace: being the Scout Centre close to the houses of other people is not allowed to make any kind of noise, including singing, from 14.00 to 16.00 and from 23.00 to 8.00.
- 5.** Fires: open fires in the fireplace can be lit only when the rooms of scout aged groups are open and available; however in addition to the written rules, common sense must be used at any time; the fires must be put out with water every night.
- 6.** Water & toilets: do not waste water (including hot water) and please use only the toilets available, leaving it as clean as possible; use only biodegradable soaps and detergents; it's not allowed to make derivations of water or electricity;
- 7.** Construction & firewood: Temporary structures built by your group must be dismantled by the end of the stay, unless you ask us and we authorize you to leave them as they are; regarding constructions, you can use the wooden poles of Roma60 only if you have booked it in advance - you can always buy wooden poles not far from the house; no one is allowed to cut trees or branches without our permission, even the bark can not be cutted or damaged, and no one is allowed to dig holes in the ground;
- 8.** Clothing: The city of Rome is very hot and humid in the summer, and we suggest that everyone brings a hat: however no one is allowed to wear swimsuit inside the fence of the house, at least shorts and T-shirt must be worn; in the evenings a sweater may be useful;
- 9.** Purchasing: nearby the Scout Centre there are shops of all kinds;
- 10.** Vehicles: Coaches, cars and motorcycles are not allowed inside the fence of the house, they must stop nearby (50 meters over the house there is a large parking area on Renzini Street), dogs or other pets must be always kept on a leash ;
- 11.** Activity: on arrival (even better before) let us know how you intend to organize the activities of your group;
- 12.** Accidents: by sending the reservation the group leaders agree with the statement that AGESCI Roma 60 is not responsible for any accidents that may occur to anyone for the mere fact of being present in the Scout House and, consequently, the group leaders will assume the responsibility for any accident;
- 13.** Phone and address: there is no public phone at the Scout Centre Rome 60, the mailing address is: AGESCI ROMA 60, Via Renzini 22, zip code 00128 Rome - Italy; It's possible and allowed to charge the mobile phones of the guest;
- 14.** An Emergency Room is available 24h at the Hospital S. Eugenio, about 10 km from the Scout Centre, the number to call for emergencies (like in the rest of Italy) is 118;

- 16.** The Scout Law is the Law of the Scout Centre Rome 60, leaving our house please remember the following thought: "Leave the world a little better than you found it";
