

HOUSE RULES

- **THE ROMA 60 SCOUT CENTER** is the headquarters of the AGESCI Rome 60 Group - whose management is inspired by being thrifty (9th article of the Scout Law) - and not a Bed & Breakfast; it's a building adapted for scout-style hospitality, and managed by scout leaders and volunteers; it is also an opportunity to meet other scouts or the inhabitants of the neighborhood.
- Only **SCOUT GROUPS, or ORGANIZED GROUPS, WITH EDUCATIONAL AND/OR TRAINING PURPOSES**, are admitted to hospitality, under the **RESPONSIBILITY OF THEIR EDUCATORS** (scout leaders, trainers, or adult teachers). The educators assume civil and criminal responsibility for any damage caused to third parties and/or structures during the group's stay. Their group's activities are managed by them directly.
- **CLEANING:** The rooms, common areas (dining room, corridors, kitchen), and toilets must all be kept clean. The Center implements **SEPARATE WASTE COLLECTION**, and everyone is obligated to adhere to proper waste management. **THROWING WASTE in the CONTAINERS at the ENTRANCE DRIVEWAY is forbidden**, as they are meant for door-to-door collection in the nearby nursery school.
- Changing the **ARRANGEMENT OF FURNITURE** in rooms and moving equipment and furnishings in the garden is prohibited without prior authorization from the Hospitality Team.
- **SILENCE AND ILLUMINATION:** As the Scout Center in the town, it is not allowed to make any kind of noise, including singing, from 2:00 PM to 4:00 PM and from 11:00 PM to 8:00 AM.
- **SMOKING IS FORBIDDEN** in the Scout Center. In open spaces, smokers must use ashtrays. Throwing butts on the ground or in the garden is strictly prohibited.
- It is possible to light **FIRES** exclusively in the reserved areas (fireplaces, external braziers, masonry barbecue) if authorized by the Hospitality Team. The fires, at the end of the activities, must always be turned off. Guests are responsible for booking or bringing their own firewood.
- To avoid waste, it is recommended to use **WATER, ELECTRICITY, AND GAS** with care. Washing of personal dishes should be carried out in the designated areas. Biodegradable soaps and detergents are recommended for use.
- **CONSTRUCTIONS:** All temporary constructions must be taken down by the end of the activity, and Roma 60 Group poles can be used if booked in advance. Cutting trees or branches or digging holes in the ground is prohibited.
- **VEHICLES** such as coaches, cars, and motorcycles are not allowed inside the enclosure or in front of the driveway. It is necessary to park them regularly along the street.
- **DOGS AND OTHER PETS** are permitted with approval from the Hospitality Team.
